The deadline for hotel reservation is Thursday May 12, 2005, but reservations should be made early to ensure room selection is available.

Barbados:

The capital of Barbados is Bridgetown. The island of Barbados is the most easterly of the Islands of the Caribbean. The total land area is 166 square miles. The climate is tropical, warm all year around and cool at nights. The average daytime temperature is 29°C (83°F). Travellers are required to pay a departure and security tax of BDS\$25.00/USD\$12.50 when leaving Barbados.

Local Airport: The Grantley Adams International Airport is a distance of around fifteen (15) km and about twenty-five (25) minutes drive time to the hotel. A typical minimum taxi charge to the hotel is in the range of BDS\$26.00 - \$36.00.

Foreign Exchange: The monetary unit is the Barbados Dollar. The exchange rate is BDS\$1.98 to US\$1.00. Traveler’s cheques, major credit cards and the US dollar are readily accepted at hotels, restaurants and shops.

Electricity: The voltage in Barbados is 110 / 220 volts AC/60 Hz.
